During his career, he fulfilled important management positions such as Head of two County Police Inspectorates (1991-2001), Deputy Head of the Romanian Police (2001-2003), General Director of the Bucharest Police General Directorate (2003-2009) and State Secretary – Head of the Schengen Department and European Affairs within the Ministry of Internal Affairs (2009-2014).

In this last capacity, he managed the whole process of fulfilling technical criteria to join the Schengen area and, after the evaluation process carried out by the European Commission, the Justice and Home Affairs Council validated by a Council Decision adopted in 2012 the fulfilment of those conditions. He coordinated as well the activity of the Ministry of Internal Affairs in the field of European Affairs, being the Romanian representative within the Operational Council for Internal Security of the European Union and attending, sometimes as Head of the delegation, the Justice and Home Affairs Council meetings.

Over the last four years he had been working as EU High Level Adviser to the General Police Inspectorate of the Republic of Moldova. In this position, he provided support to the Ministry of Internal Affairs and to the General Police Inspectorate of the Republic of Moldova to develop strategic documents in the field of Police Reform and to approximate the legal and internal framework to the European standards. Moreover, he provided support in the implementation of modern concepts in the activity of Moldovan Police such as Intelligence Led Policing, Police Equal Performance, Community Policing.
